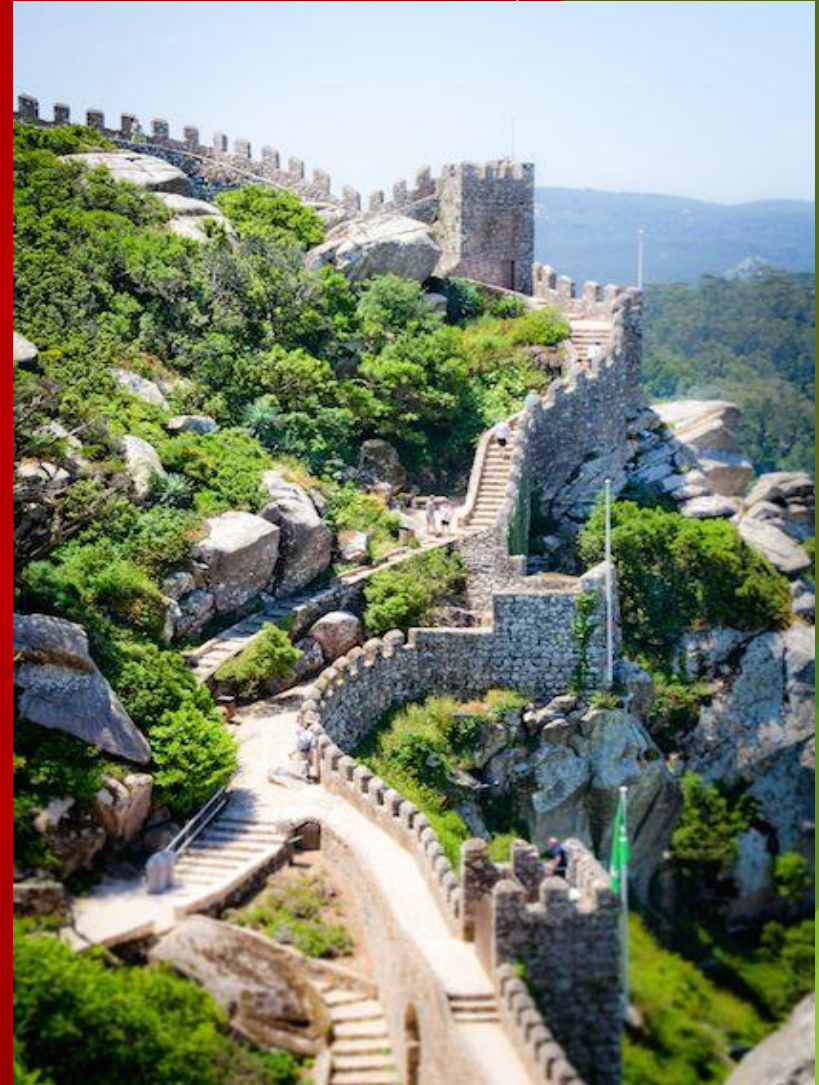
Interesting facts about Portugal

I've heard that genetis occur here they are so cute that i would love to see them.

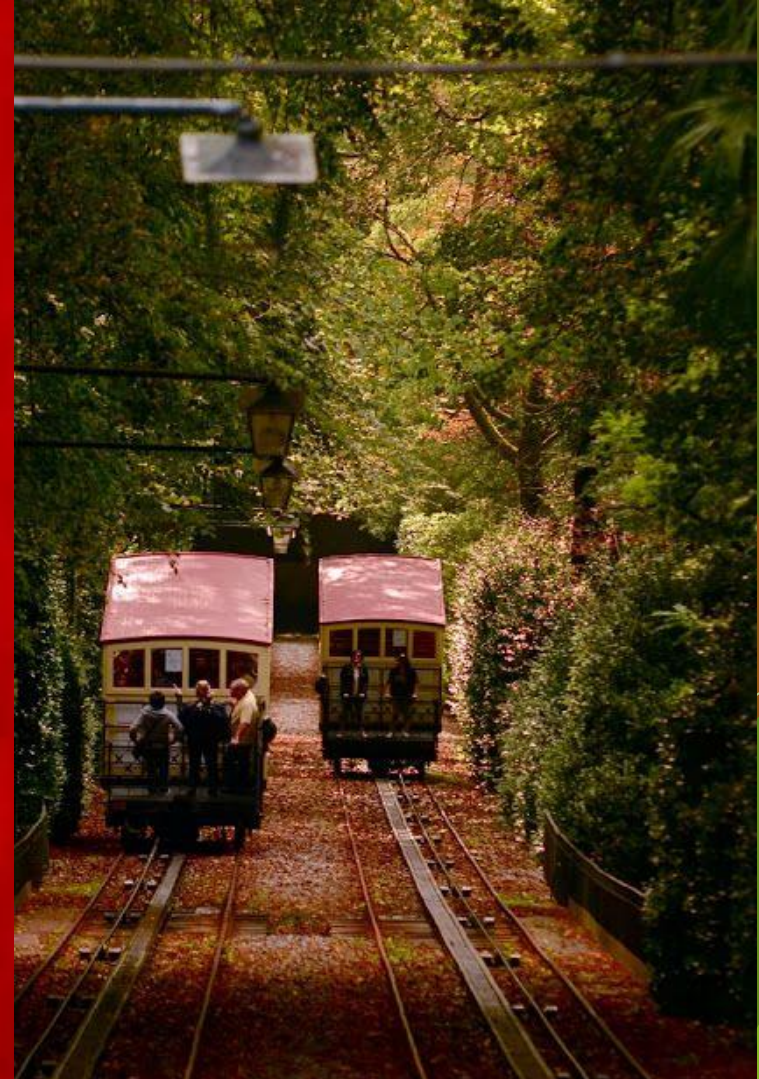
I am curious if the animals there are different from those in Poland.
